Jon & Cindy Hann Dog Training Seminar
May 10, 11, 12
Dave Lincoln's Sporthaven (about 4 miles north of Bennett)

Friday May 10, starting promptly at 7 pm there will be an introduction to the seminar. The location is the Valhalla~Bijou Hunt Club club house. Seating and parking will be tight. Bring a folding chair. There are some chairs there but not enough for everyone. Try to carpool if at all possible and compact cars are better than full sized pickups. Parking will be head in and someone will be there to direct the parking. If you want something to drink, bring it! Remember, the cost of this seminar is nominal and neither Skyline or the GSP clubs are making anything off of it. Be on time!

Directions to Valhalla~Bijou: Head east on I-70 to exit 304, the Bennett exit. At the stop sign at the top of the exit ramp turn right onto CR 133 and go south 1 1/2 miles (The last 1/2 mile or so is a narrow private drive - DRIVE SLOWLY). The club house is a quonset hut structure on your left.

Saturday, May 11, we will start promptly at 8 am at Dave Lincoln's place north of Bennett. I will ask Jon to start on time so if you straggle you may miss something important. We will have lunch hosted by the Skyline Brittany Club for \$4.00 a person. We will go until 4 pm officially. Plan for the possibility of running a little later.

Sunday, May 12, we will start promptly at 8 am and go to 4 pm. The German Shorthair Club of Colorado will be hosting lunch for \$4.00 a person.

Participants will be the only ones bringing a dog. Observers, please leave your dogs at home. There will be stake outs for the dogs. Please clean up after your dogs! We are guests at the Lincoln's facility. Bring water or drinks for your personal use. We will have a beverage for lunch but not necessarily for the entire day. Dress appropriately as you will be outside all day long. Bring a hat, sunscreen, etc.

Directions to Dave Lincoln's place: Head east on I-70 to exit 304, the Bennett exit. At the stop sign at the top of the exit ramp turn left onto Hwy 79, cross over I-70 and go north a long mile to the junctions with Hwy 36. Turn right and go east about 1/4 mile, turn left (staying on Hwy 79) at the Co-op and cross over the RR tracks and turn right at the T intersection. Hwy 79 goes east about 3/4 miles and then makes a sweeping left to head north again. After the turn it is about 4 1/2 miles to CR 72. Turn right onto CR 72 and go east 1 mile. Turn right through the gate and follow the drive about 1/2 mile to the parking area. Again parking is tight so car pooling and compact cars are encouraged.

Jon is bringing dogs to use for demonstration (these are dogs that he is training for customers). Each participant will work with their own dogs. Jon will also have copies of his video available for sale.
