As you know we will be holding our spring trial this year in Hill City Kansas utilizing several sections of Private ground.

We have received an astounding amount of support from the entire community in putting this trial together including the Hill City Chamber of Commerce. And many of the local farmer/ranchers. We therefore would ask everyone to be good guests.

The rules for running on these grounds are pretty simple.

1. Clean up after ourselves leaving the grounds as we found them
2. Fill in any dog holes and spread out the horse manure.

Please remember our gallery rules; that **NO ONE RIDE ON ANY WINTER WHEAT OR ANY OTHER PLANTED**

reserve the right to rearrange the running order should conditions warrant.

COURSES AND BIRDS

Open All Age, Open Gun Dog and Armature Gun Dog shall be run on single courses with no bird field. The Open Derby and Open Puppy shall be run on Single Courses without bird fields. The trial shall be run with native Pheasant and Bobwhite quail and released Pheasant or Bobwhite quail. Birds shall be released in all stakes except the Open Puppy. No blanks shall be fired in the Open Puppy. Blank pistols and shotguns firing blank shells only shall be permitted.
