Courses and Birds

Open Puppy single course as an alternating course out and in without bird field, no birds released. All other stakes to be single course as an alternating course out and in without bird field.

Bob-white quail released in all stakes except Open Puppy. A blank cartridge will not be fired in the Open Puppy stake. Horseback handling is permitted in all stakes. This trial will be recognized by the AFTCA. All blank guns must have a solid barrel or be plugged. No live ammunition allowed on the grounds.

The courses are located along Soldier Creek, which is a live creek that is located among the 20,000+ acres of the park. The facilities are close and comfortable. There is lodging available in the park within walking distance of the starting line.

Lodging facilities are restored to a historic representation of the original fort with some modern conveniences. They are clean and comfortable. No TV or phone.

Reservations: When you make a reservation be sure to mention you are with the field trial club, especially for horse stalls. You want to keep horses in the "mare barn" as it is closest to the starting line.

Park Fee: \$2.50 per day or a yearly pass \$14.00

Most services require a reservation, prices do not include reservation fees.

CAMPING: Primitive area \$9 per night; Modern area with electric hookup \$13.00

LODGING SEASON: Early April - late November

CABINS/ADOBES: Sleeps 6, \$80/nt -- Sleeps 8, \$90/nt -- Sleeps 10, \$100/nt --

LODGE ROOMS: Double bed, \$35/nt --- 2 twin beds, \$40/nt

You may not stake out, use electric corrals, or tie your horse to the trailer.

To keep your horse on the grounds you must rent a stall. Sorry, no exceptions!

Food: Lunch will be catered daily by park food service \$6.00 per plate.

Saturday night dinner on the grounds will be served by park food service.

Meals will be served in the Mare Barn Annex Building.

Attention All Field Trial Participants

Bring the family. You don't have to get up at dawn here, the rooms are within walking distance of the field trial area. There are fishing lakes, jeep rides (\$7.00/\$5.00child), and horse drawn tours (\$4.00/\$2.50 child)available. There are also self-guided tours of the historic area. Please remember we are guests of Fort Robinson State Park. This property must be kept clean. Please clean-up after your dogs and fill any holes created by dogs or horses. We have been asked to stake out dogs for a reasonable amount of time only. Please make every effort to preserve the natural environment, including vegetation, soil, water and wildlife.
