AKC rules regarding qualifications standards and conduct of the braces are available from the event secretary. Qualifications standards are also available on the AKC website at www.AKC.org. Braces may be adjusted as necessary by the event officials during the hunt test.

AKC approved tracking collars may be used. A list of AKC approved models is at www.akc.org/events/hunting_tests/pointing_breeds/tracking_.cfm.

Refund Policy - Once an entrant is drawn and braced (Tuesday, June 9th, 2009 at 7pm), it may move up to the next test level, run as entered, or scratch without refund. Refunds will be granted **ONLY** for bitches in season, injured or sick dogs (may require veterinary certification); issues that are our fault (event cancelled due to weather, etc), or circumstances deemed special/emergency by the event committee. After receipt of entry and payment, owners needing to withdraw their entry prior to Tuesday June 9th, 2009 at 7:00pm must request same to the test secretary by email/phone. Scratches will be confirmed by email by the hunt test committee. Entrants who qualify for a title during test #2009079853 may request advancement to the next level for event # 2009079854 to the event secretary within 30 minutes of the test beginning. No refunds will be given to entrants who qualify at one level and choose not to advance to the next level. Entrants previously qualified at the level in which they are entered and registered can run at the same level and will be awarded the standard AKC rosette upon qualification at that level if they pass.

If not previously completed, all participants are required to complete a release of liability to Rocky Mountain Roosters Inc prior to entrance upon the grounds. The Release of Liability form is attached as an insert to the premium.

Water is available on site. Indoors bathroom facilities are available inside the club house. Dogs are not permitted to be off leash except during running of their brace. Dogs are not permitted inside any building at any time.

Lunch will be available for \$5 in the club house each day. Please indicate your reservation in the space at the bottom of premium.

Limited on site camping is permitted only at the west end of the clubhouse parking lot. Utility hook-ups are not available. Overnight stake outs are not permitted. Please clean up after your dogs. See the event secretary for camping location assignment upon arrival. Reservations for camping sites are requested.

All test levels are a single course with birdfield. Quail, chukkar, or pheasant will be used for all tests.

Junior Hunt Test will run 15 minutes. Senior and Master will run 30 minutes.

OTHER RESTRICTIONS and FEATURES

Makes check payable to "GSCA". Payment must accompany premium. No dogs will be drawn or braced without prior payment. **NO EXCEPTIONS.**

Only starter pistols with blank cartridges may be fired by handlers.

Participants must wear blaze orange on the senior and master course. Gallery's are permitted only at the discretion of the hunt test committee and judges when safety permits, are under the control of the marshall, and not permitted in any bird field.

Judges have the authority to disqualify a dog that is not present within five minutes after it is called to run by the judges.

Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians' recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations including state required rabies vaccination.

Standard AKC Rosettes will be awarded to all dogs receiving a qualifying score.

GSCA Hunt Test Information Sheet

First, thank you for your entry to the Gordon Setter Club of America AKC sanctioned hunt tests that are being conducted by the High Plains Area Committee of the GSCA.

Attached are the brace postings for AKC Hunt Test #2009079853 (Sat June 13th) and #2009079854 (Sun June 14th). The file is a MS Excel 1997-2003 compatible version. Further, the braces will be posted at www.fieldtrialnews.com for download. Should you have a concern or feel we may have missed something, please contact us right away by responding to this email. Per AKC regulations, the hunt test committee has the latitude to change the brace order during the event.

Getting There: Please see www.fieldtrialnews.com for a detailed map for locating the grounds. The roads near the site are high quality but dirt, so please be careful and proceed slowly as dogs will be running braces. Look for signs (black signs with orange lettering “HT”) located along the roads as you approach the test grounds. Generally, the grounds are located about 1 hour and 20 minutes South East of Denver or 45 minutes East of Colorado Springs. It is an excellent facility with a large club house that we will be using for check-in, lunch, bathroom facilities, and staying warm if need be! Unfortunately, dogs are not permitted in the club house and must be leashed when not running their braces. We ask you to respect their rules in this matter. Guests are encouraged. This is a comfortable site to bring those who may not normally come to a hunt test, so we encourage you bring friends and family. Please make sure you have completed your release of liability upon check in with the event secretary in the main club house upon arrival, if you have not already done so.

Check-In: Check in is at the main clubhouse. There will be a table inside the main clubhouse with a packet for you that contains the event catalog and other information. The hunt test secretary will be at this location throughout both events. Check in will open at 7:15 each morning. If you have a question during the event, she can always seek an answer for you. Any changes during the events will be known by the test secretary.

Friday Evening Arrival: The west parking lot of the main clubhouse is available for overnight parking for the event for participants. Please check in with the event staff in the main clubhouse to help you locate the correct parking area. Parking immediately adjacent to the starting lines is reserved for the horse trailers and judges. Thanks for your cooperation.

Weather Issues/Delay-Cancellation Decisions: The extended forecast for Calhan Colorado for Saturday is partly cloudy with a high of 75' and a low of 51'. Sunday's forecast is isolated T-storms with a high of 75' and a low of 50'. Braces have been limited such that we can handle a reasonable weather delay if necessary due to rain. Weather decisions regarding course safety are made by the judges.

Food Service: Dave and Elizabeth of Daveswienerwagon@aol.com will be providing lunches (two menu's) for a nominal charge. They will be serving throughout each day, and you can stop by at your convenience. There will be complimentary coffee service provided by the High Plains Gordon Setter Club. So please enjoy a hot cup of coffee on us at any time during the event, and especially as you arrive and check-in. Dave and Liz will also be providing burrito's for breakfast on a first come/first serve basis.

Course Coordinators: Heather Fiedler will be coordinating the junior course line, and Cory Ling the senior/master. Unless otherwise announced, the brace starting times remain 8:30am for the juniors, and 8:00am for the senior/masters. The remaining braces are as called by the judges; *the judges have called all braces in immediate succession to the previous brace.* This means you need to be at the starting line waiting on the judges as they ride in from the previous brace. Thank you for your help in this matter. Please review the 5 minute disqualification judge's option for dogs not present as called. *If you are one of the early braces, plan accordingly in respect to your travel to the Calhan.* Note that the seniors run first on Saturday and the Master's run first on Sunday. If you handling dogs on both courses, please keep us advised if you see a problem with being ready for your brace on either course. Should a gallery be permitted, please take the directions of the marshals.

Qualification Results: The brace coordinators (Heather and Cory) will collect the judges' scorecards after the braces. Please feel free to get an "unofficial" result from either when they have a moment. The results are collected by the hunt test secretary and captured in the official judge's scorebook. At the conclusion of the event, the judges affirm the results were captured correctly on the scorecard and sign the form. *At that time*, the results are official. Qualifying rosettes will be presented during the day as practical, and at the conclusion of the event each day by the hunt test secretary. There is a scorecard in your catalog where you can capture results for your training records. The catalog also contains AKC guidance on scoring.

Please approach me or any member of the committee with suggestions or concerns during the event. Our best wishes that you find birds and we will see you there on Saturday morning.
