Eligibility of Dogs

1. Any Weimaraner with an individual AKC number, including an AKC "limited Registration" and/or an ILP number who has obtained the age of six months on the first advertised day of the tests may compete for any or all of the ratings offered. Dogs with disqualifying faults must have obtained a DFQ number from the WCA prior to entering this Ratings Test. DGQ numbers must be on file with the WCA Secretary prior to these tests.

2. Ratings Tests are open to all Weimaraners whose owners and co-owners are members of The Weimaraner Club of America.

3. Additional rules and regulations are available on the www.Weimclubamerica.org web site. Please check all rules and regulations prior to entering your dog.

Rules and Regulations

1. No dog is permitted to practice on the rating test grounds on the day of the Rating test
2. Dogs cannot be off lead on the test grounds except for the actual time they are being judged
3. Only a leather or nylon collar and/or a red, yellow or green reflective collar can be worn by dogs participating in ratings tests. No training aids check cords, pinch, spike or choke collars, electronic or dummy devices are permitted.
4. Bitches in season will be allowed to run after all other dogs have run.

We are having this event on private property. Please clean up after your dogs, Park in designated areas only. Bring shade and clean water for your dogs.

Directions

From Nebraska take I-76 South to Hudson, CO. The road is HWY 52. Go East to Beech St, there is a pedestrian crossing sign, turn right until you get to County Road 4. Turn left past the tree farm and look for marker designating "Field Event".

From Denver take I-76 north or I-25 north to HWY 52. Follow directions above.
