Braces may be adjusted by the event committee during the hunting tests as necessary.

All tests open to all AKC Pointing Breeds that are at least 6 months of age and registered with, or granted an ILP by the AKC. Bitches in season will not be permitted to run.

"Makes check payable to "RMVC". Payment must accompany entry. No dogs will be drawn or braced without prior payment. NO EXCEPTIONS."

Premium forms and brace information is available on www.fieldtrialnews.com and www.rmvc.org. Contact Janice Branam at branamj@comcast.net to receive by e-mail.

Once an entrant is drawn and braced, it may run as entered, move up to the next test level, or scratch without refund. Refunds will be granted only for bitches in season and injured or sick dogs (may require vet certification); or as deemed an emergency by the event committee. Entrants who complete a title during #2010661103 may request advancement to the next level for event # 2010661104 to the event secretary within 30 minutes of the test start.

COURSES AND BIRDS

Senior and Master Hunt Tests will run 30 minutes. Junior Hunt Test will run 15 minutes. Tests will run on a single course with bird field. Quail, Chucker and/or Pheasant will be released in all stakes.

Shotguns with blank shells will not be permitted. Only starter pistols with blank cartridges may be fired by handlers.

Participants must wear blaze orange on the senior and master courses. Judges and officials only are allowed to use horses. Gallery's are permitted only at the discretion of the hunt test committee and judges when safety permits, are under the control of the marshal, and not permitted in any bird field.

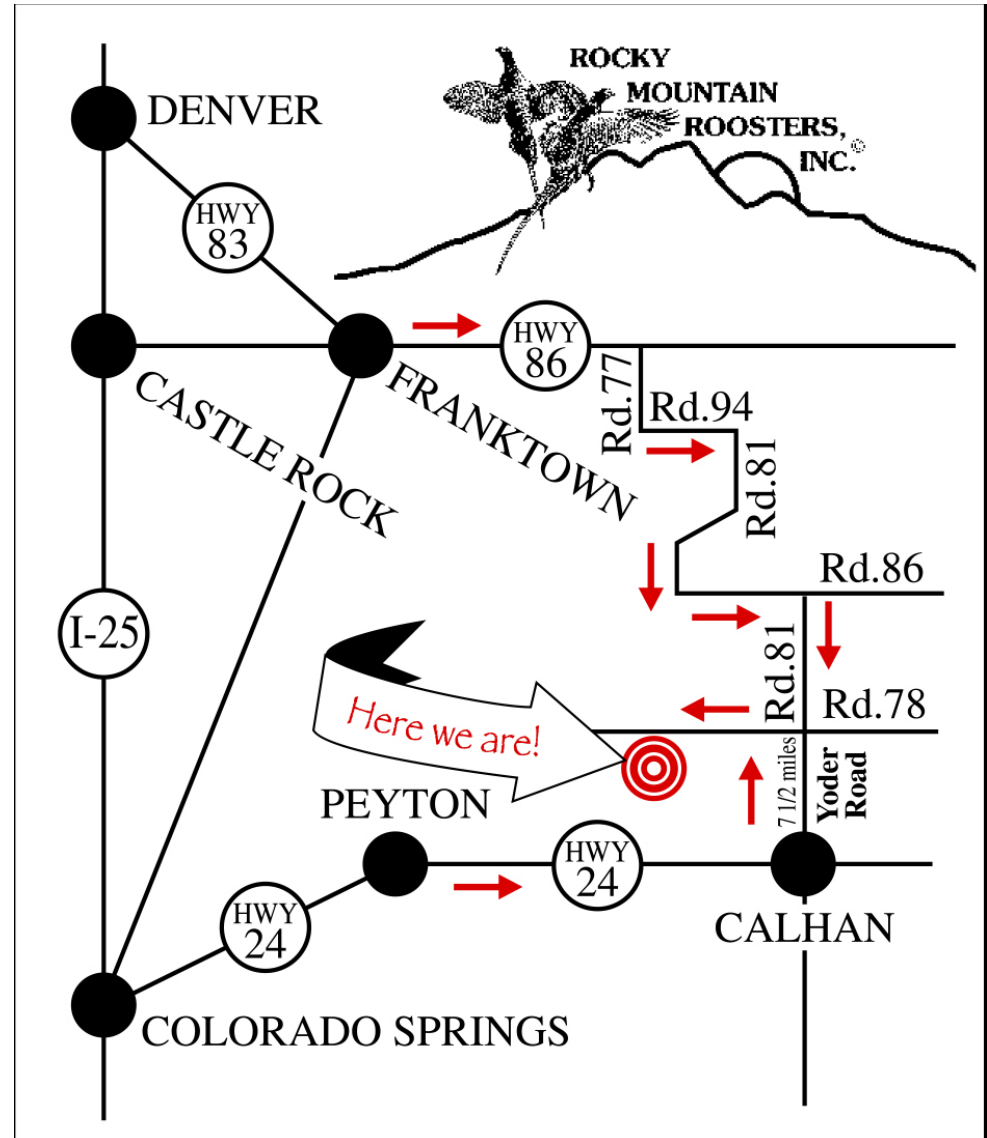
DIRECTIONS TO HUNT TEST GROUNDS

DIRECTIONS FROM DENVER:

South on I-25 to the Founders Parkway Exit just north of Castle Rock. (Factory outlet store here) East on the Parkway to the intersection of Hwy 86. Continue East on Hwy 86 past the town of Kiowa (9.5 miles) and you will see a sign that points to Calhan, this is Road 77. (dirt roads from here on!) Drive South on Road 77 to the "T" intersection (6.2 miles) , turn Left on Road 94 and follow it around (1 mile) and it turns into Road 81. Continue South on Road 81 to Road 78 (4.2 miles), turn Right and Rocky Mountain Roosters is at the bottom of the hill (1/4 mile, about 12 miles from Hwy 86).

DIRECTIONS FROM COLORADO SPRINGS:

East on Hwy 24 to Calhan. North on Calhan Highway which is one of the last streets in town. (There is a sign that points to the Airport, this is the Road!) Drive 7.5 miles, you will come off pavement and your next left will be Road 78. Turn Left and drive 3/4 mile to the entrance of Rocky Mountain Roosters.



HUNT TEST GROUNDS AND FACILITIES

All participants are required to complete a Release of Liability and Waiver to Rocky Mountain Rooster Inc, prior to entrance to the grounds. The release from is attached as an insert to the premium and must be submitted with the entry.

Indoor bathrooms facilities are available inside the club house. Dogs are not permitted inside any building at any time. Dogs are not permitted to be off leash except during the running of their brace. Please clean up after your dogs.

Participant vehicles are permitted only in the designated Club House parking lot. Limited on site camping is permitted only at the west end of the clubhouse parking lot. Utility hook ups are not available. Overnight stake outs are not permitted. Please RSVP with your entry to the event secretary if an overnight camping assignment is requested.

Standard AKC Rosettes will be awarded to all dogs receiving a qualifying score.

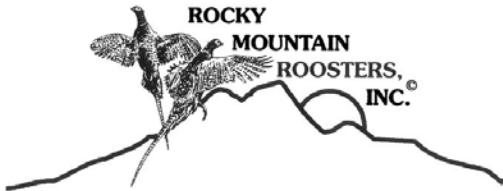
