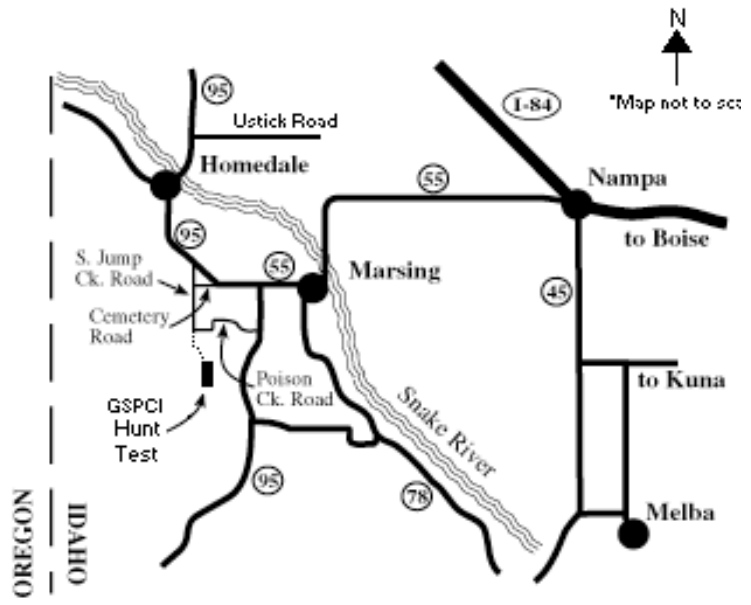

Directions to Jump Creek Recreation Area

FROM BOISE: Take I-84 west to exit 33A, and cross over the freeway going south on ID-55. This exit is close to the recommended motels in Nampa. Continue south on ID-55. It is 14 miles to the Snake River bridge at Marsing, ID. Continue through town. It is two miles to the ION Truck Stop and the end of ID-55. Continue straight on US-95 North toward Homedale, ID. Jump Creek Road is 3.4 miles. Turn hard left (Look for event signs). Go south on Jump Creek Road. The pavement ends in 4 miles, keep going straight. In 0.4 miles the road crosses an irrigation canal. You are getting close! Follow signs from here south to the test site. It is about one mile.

FROM OREGON: Take I-84 east to Exit 3. Turn right, south on US-95. Continue 28 miles to the Snake River at Homedale, ID. (There are no recommended motels on this route.) Continue on US-95. It is 4.5 miles to Jump Creek Road. Turn right. Look for event signs, this turn is easy to miss. (If you reach the ION Truck Stop you have gone too far.) Go south on Jump Creek Road. The pavement ends in 4 miles, keep going straight. In 0.4 miles the road crosses an irrigation canal. You are getting close! Follow signs from here south to the test site. It is about



one mile.
