NATIONAL CHAMPIONSHIP—Open to any Weimaraner which at the time entries close for this stake is a Field Champion or an Amateur Field Champion, or has placed first, second, third, or fourth, in any AKC broke dog stake such as an Open or Amateur All-Age stake, or an Open or Amateur Gun Dog stake. The event, stake and placement that qualified the dog to be entered shall be submitted with the entry.

NATIONAL AMATEUR CHAMPIONSHIP—Open to any Weimaraner which at the time entries close for this stake, while being owned by an Amateur, has earned its Field Championship or an Amateur Field Championship, or has placed first, second, third, or fourth, in any AKC broke dog stake such as an Open or Amateur All-Age stake, or an Open or Amateur Gun Dog stake. The event, stake and placement that qualified the dog to be entered shall be submitted with the entry. Only persons who, in the judgement of the Field Trial Committee, are qualified as amateurs, as defined in Chapter 14, Section 2, of the AKC Rules for Pointing Breed Trials may serve as scout in the National Amateur Championship Stake.

OPEN DERBY and **NATIONAL FUTURITY** open to Weimaraners only.

Bitches in Season may compete in all stakes.

This Field Trial is held under Rules and Procedures of the American Kennel Club.

COURSES AND BIRDS

Tracking collars will be permitted in all stakes as per AKC rules.

National Championship and National Amateur Championship - continuous courses with native quail on course. Call back for dogs in contention only, for retrieve on pheasants.

Open Derby and National Field Futurity - continuous courses with native quail on course.

Committee reserves the right to release quail on back course. Blank pistols will be used - .22 caliber crimps shall not be used.

National Championship and the National Amateur Championship are retrieving stakes.

Horseback handling will be permitted in all stakes.

PRIZES

Standard AKC rosettes to all placed dogs.

Trophies to all placed dogs in each stake.

WCA Rotating trophy for the first placed dog in each stake.

50% of the entry fees (Net of Ground Use and Other Such Fees) in the National Championship and the Open Derby to be divided as follows:

40%-30%-20%-10% if four placements

50%-30%-20% if three placements,

70%-30% if two placements, and 100% of one placement.

If first through fourth places in a money stake are withheld, prize money portion of the entries will be retained by WCA Treasurer and added to the purse for the same stake next year.

Both the National and Amateur Championships will be one hour stakes with a finished retrieve at the judge’s discretion. The National Futurity and the Derby will be 30 minute stakes.

Ardmore, OK in December can be a mix of all weather types. The WCANFT Committee hopes to complete this year’s Nationals by Sunday, December 10. Weather and entry numbers can affect the running of individual stakes.
