Grounds: From the New Jersey Turnpike, exit 7A onto Route I-195 east to exit 11 (Imlaystown-Cox's Corner), turn north and follow brown Assunpink W.M.A. signs until you see the new administration building. Just beyond turn right into the Conservation Center.

Premiums Please submit a separate entry for each stake. Premiums and checks must be received by the Field Trial Secretary prior to the time of closing on Friday, September 15, 2006. No telephone entries will be accepted.

Horses Handler and gallery horses will be available at the grounds from our wrangler, Wayne Scubelek. Horse rental is not included in the entry fees. A limited number of horses are available for rent. **ADVANCED RESERVATIONS** are required through Wayne @ 717-264-6476. All horses brought onto the grounds must have documentation of a current negative Coggins test.
