WCA ROTATING TROPHIES TO FIRST PLACE DOG IN OPEN ALL-AGE, AMATEUR GUN DOG AND OPEN DERBY.

## **2010 WCA Mid-America Field Classic & Mid-America Field Futurity**

**Grounds:** Rolling hills, babbling brooks, open meadows, forested ridges, and a lake nestled in the middle of it all—that's Ionia State Recreation Area.

Forty-five hundred acres of Central Michigan's scenic lands comprise the Ionia multi-use recreation area. Here, also, is where the Ionia Field Trial Grounds are located.

**Horses:** Bottom Creek Farm, owned and operated by Will and Kathi Langley, are once again supplying top quality equine for the event. Please contact them at (810) 724-3426 or via email [Will@bottomcreekfarm.com](mailto:Will@bottomcreekfarm.com) to reserve handlers or gallery horses prior to the trial.

**Camping:** Camping on the grounds is permitted costing \$6.00 per day. A limited number of electrical hookups are available for campers for an additional \$4.00 per day (registration/payment to SMWC as your host). Michigan DNR Vehicle parking permits are \$4.00 daily and Annual vehicle parking permits are \$24.00 (good for all Michigan State Parks). The Michigan DNR officers inspect the parking area daily and will happily sell you the parking passes (keep an eye out for their green truck).

**Food:** Food will be available during the running of the trial. Breakfast, lunch and dinner will be cooked daily.
